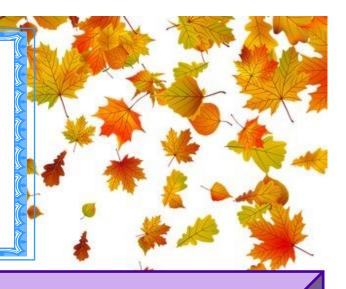

Physical Therapy

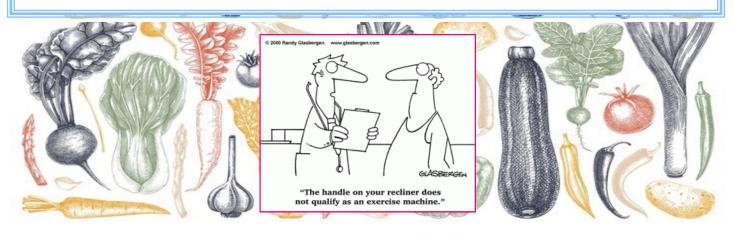
Mobility, Strength and Flexibility: Focused exercises can enhance mobility and flexibility, making everyday activities easier.
